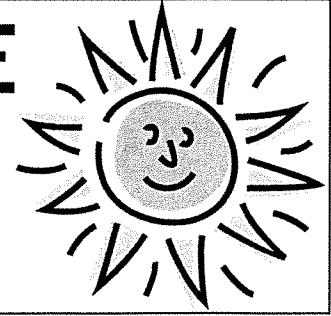

CAMPER CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE POLICY

Camp Northvale not only provides fun and learning experiences, but also stresses respect for the environment and others. Therefore, all parents and participants must understand and follow the camp guidelines and rules. The following sets forth general rules of conduct and sets forth procedures for handling disciplinary offenses by campers. Camp Northvale reserves the right to bypass one or more of the steps set forth below if the Director deems such action to be warranted. Camp Northvale reserves the right to suspend or expel any camper from the program who poses serious continual discipline problems, whether or not all of the steps in our discipline procedure have been completed.

General Rules of Conduct

1. Listen to staff
2. Remain within a specific area assigned for a specific activity
3. Exhibit respect for the authority of all camp personnel
4. Maintain and respect Borough property
5. Speak to and treat adults and other campers with respect
6. Refrain from using inappropriate or foul language or gestures
7. Avoid placing themselves or others in danger of physical harm
8. Refrain from deliberate or intentional hitting or touching
9. Keep Borough camp facilities clean
10. Respect all staff, camper, guests, and follow rules of any facility camp activities are located.

Discipline for Offenses

1st Offense: Verbal warning followed by a note in file

2nd Offense: Loss of the next day activities and telephonic notification of parent/guardian. Signed copy of this policy must be returned to Camp staff prior to Campers return to activities.

3rd Offense: Written notice to parent/guardian

4th Offense: Termination from program or session. Termination is at the Director's discretion and no refunds will be given.
