Thank you for your interest in the Northvale Police Department Junior Police Academy. It is our goal to reach out to young people such as yourself, and inspire good citizenship by educating you about the Criminal Justice System.

Because this program demands the best from its participants, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Students must be in Grade 7 or Grade 8 and maintain an 80% average. Students who have below an 80% average may ask for a waiver. Further information regarding this waiver may be obtained by contacting Sgt. Essmann or Officer Pizzi.
2. Students must not have been arrested or referred to the Juvenile Conference Committee. Students having a conflict with this requirement may contact Sgt. Essmann or Officer Pizzi for further information.
3. Students must not be involved with any form of substance abuse, i.e., cigarettes, alcohol, drugs.
4. Attendance is mandatory in order to successfully complete the program. Certain exceptions may be made for conflicts in schedule, including, but not limited to, sports programs, school related functions, etc. Students may contact Sgt. Essmann or Officer Pizzi in reference to absence.
5. Parents/Guardians must complete and return a "Release of Liability Form."
6. Students must complete, sign and return the enclosed application. Any and all required signatures must be completed.

Applications are available through the Nathan Hale Guidance Office and the Northvale Police Department. All forms must be completed and signed by the appropriate person(s) and returned to Officer Pizzi no later than, (TBA). Please note that class size will be limited to 50 students. All stages of acceptance to the Junior Police Academy will be based on the order the applications are received.

Unless otherwise noted, all Junior Police Academy classes will be held at the Nathan Hale School from 6:30 P.M. to 8:30 PM. The Junior Police Academy will prove to be a valuable and rewarding experience for all involved. If selected to participate in this program, students will be notified and receive more detailed information regarding the program.
